WORM EGG COUNTS

The past couple of years have been very challenging to manage worms in most sheep enterprises.

This year (2023) we have for the first time worm egg (WEC) sampled all of the 2022 drop individually. By WEC sampling both the rams and ewes we will be able to put greater pressure genetically on WEC.

As this is our first year testing we are pleased with the results so far. The average for the 2022 drop is -7.5, placing us in the 60th percentile. We still have some improvement to make however we have a start and a direction to continue to improve (lower) the impact of worms to our clients.

In February this year, Sheep Genetics recognised all of the breeders who have achieved a 5 Star data quality score rating. Kambah Poll Merinos was one of the flocks who have achieved this status.

The data quality score is based on a 5 year average for the amount and quality of pedigree submitted to Sheep Genetics along with trait recording and how effective the data is to make Australian Sheep Breeding Value (ASBV) predictions.

The new star rating system gives breeders an indication of the quality of a flocks data. Having a high DQS is very important in enhancing the reliability of highly accurate ASBVs.

At Kambah Poll Merinos we are working constantly to maintain our Data Quality.




2023 RAM SALE AND OPEN DAY
